	The goal of this network action is to enable a 2-month visit of Tom Froese (a doctoral student at the CCNR Centre for Computational Neuroscience & Robotics, University of Sussex, UK) to the SCAI Lab, University of Skövde, Sweden. The general aim of the visit is to establish collaboration between CCNR and SCAI Lab.
Goals of the action	The focus of the visit will be to establish collaboration for the development of a critical analysis and future roadmap of work on artificial consciousness from the perspective of a systemic approach to life and mind. A central aspect of Froese's DPhil studies is to clarify the relationship between empirical investigations into the synthesis of artificial autonomous systems and the theoretical foundations of a systemic understanding of life, mind, and language. Research in the SCAI Lab on the relationship between life and (artificial/machine) consciousness, is very relevant to Froese's research, and vice versa.
