Goals of the action	The goal of the workshop is to provide an international, interdisciplinary forum on the topic of computational attention in cognitive systems, with the purpose to advance understanding of the state-of-the-art on attention, i.e., bottom-up and top-down processes for the selection of information in the context of artificial cognitive systems, for interested members of euCognition. This is the first international symposium known so far that will focus on this topic which is supposed to be at the core of cognitive systems in general, currently being an intensively studied scientific topic of several EU funded projects on artificial cognitive systems. The workshop WAPCV 2007 will be held January 8, 2007, in Hyderabad, India, in association to IJCAI 2007 (see web site http://dib.joanneum.at/wapcv2007). The workshop has been accepted by the IJCAI workshop review committee, the review process on numerous submitted papers is at the moment still on-going. IJCAI represents a major event for many researchers in euCognition. WAPCV 2007 stands in the tradition of WAPCV 2003 (ICVS, Graz, funded by ECVision), 2004 (ECCV, Prague, funded by ECVision), 2005 (CVPR, San Diego). WAPCV 2007 has been announced on the euCognition web site. The Program Committee has received the attention, e.g., so far as by paper submission, by numerous members of euCognition.
