Goals of the action	- To enable a 5-month research/exchange visit of student Fabio Ruini (Italian National Research Council ISTC-CNR) to Prof. Cangelosi's lab in Plymouth. Fabio Ruini is currently at the Institute of Cognitive Science and Technology (CNR) with Proff. Parisi and Nolfi. His research project, as part of his MSc thesis, regards artificial life models of prey-predator behaviour and the adaptive value of different prey response strategies. Fabio will continue this line of research at the University of Plymouth, in particular with new focus will be on the emergence of communication in different social and interaction scenarios including cooperation and competition. Through his visit at the University of Plymouth, Fabio will acquire new research skills on evolution of language and interact with other staff and students in Plymouth working on models of language evolution and acquisition. - To support collaboration between Prof. Cangelosi's lab in Plymouth and the ISTC-CNR group on Artificial Life and Cognitive Robotics. The two labs are currently planning a joint FP7 Cognitive Systems project proposal. This student exchange action will permit a closer collaboration and interaction between the University of Plymouth and the ISTC-CNR.
