Goals of the action	- To enable the continuation of the research visit of PhD student Vadim Tikhanoff (University of Plymouth) to the robotics lab at the Italian Institute of Technology (Genoa). During the previous 5 months of Vadim's visit in Genoa he has developed the speech processing, SOM learning and vision modules for new language learning/grounding experiments with iCub (see report and outcome of previous action). Due to the complexity of the experiments, he now requires four additional months of support to complete the experiments. Note that in addition to the language learning experiments with iCub, during the previous visit Vadim also developed a new prototype simulator of iCub which is currently being used by others at IIT. - To further support the establishment of new research collaboration between Plymouth and Genoa. This action proposal will permit the bridging of funding between the euCognition previous action NA97-2 and the new FP7 IP project ITALK which will start in early 2008. Vadim's prototype experiment and iCub simulator will be very valuable in the ITALK project on language and action integration studies using the iCub platform.
