Goals of the action	After the success of ABiALS 2006 (funded with the network action NA066_1), we propose the ABiALS 2008 workshop: "the fourth workshop on Anticipatory Behavior in Adaptive Learning Systems". The general aim of the ABiALS workshop is to bring together researchers that are interested in anticipatory adaptive behavior in primate, and artificial.
	adaptive behavior in animals, animats, and artificial intelligence systems. We stress the multidisciplinary nature of this scientific enterprise, and welcome researchers from different disciplines, including cognitive robotics, psychology, neuroscience, and philosophy among others.
	Anticipatory behavior does not only depend on the past and present but also on predictions, expectations, or beliefs about the future. The expected outcome of the workshop is to discuss and evaluate the different influences that predictions, expectations, goals, desires, or intentions can have on actual behavior, including influences on attention, action decision making and control, as well as learning.
	During the workshop there will be two invited overview talks on anticipatory mechanisms (from two different perspectives, computer science and empirical science), short presentations of concrete approaches in artificial cognitive systems, and several interactive discussion sessions.
	Our initiative is highly synergic with the Fifth euCognition Six-Monthly Meeting, having as a theme: "The Role of Anticipation in Cognition". We plan to coordinate these two events, that will be held in two successive days (26 and 27 June 2008).

We will also freely distribute copies of the CD during the Fifth euCognition Six-Monthly Meeting. We will contribute a Cognition Briefing to the euCognition Wiki on the theme "Anticipation and anticipatory behavior."

Invited speakers. We will have two invited speakers. The costs will cover their travel and subsistence costs. Requested funds: €2,000 Proceedings. Like in ABiALS 2006, we plan an electronic publication. The funds will be used for printing 200 CD physical copies, managing the registration of the CD copyrights (with Italian SIAE), and shipping the CDs. The CD copies will be distributed freely at the workshop and at other events after the workshop. During the workshop we will also distribute a abstract booklet of the contributions. Requested funds: €1,000 Website. A web portal on the ABiALS theme: "Anticipatory Behavior in Adaptive Learning Systems". We will create a stable thematic web resource for our interdisciplinary community, that will include not only the ABiALS proceedings, but also other material such as videos, presentations, sourcecode, an annotated bibliography, etc., as well as other web facilities for "community building" such a thematic forum and a newsletter. This portal will link the euCognition portal, too. Requested funds: €2,000 Note that the CD and website realization will be delegated to two SMEs that will give us receipts for the service.
