3. TARGET AUDIENCE

The school is oriented towards scientists, researchers and students working in the field of multimodal communication who are invited (COST 2102 MC members are particularly invited to contribute and /or report on COST 2102 activities) to submit short contributions to allow exchanges and discussions with the invited speakers.

4. ORGANIZATION

The school is organized as a series of lectures presented by the invited speakers, with short presentations given by the participants that will focus on recent developments and open problems in the field of multimodal signals in face-to-face interactions.







5. AIMS

The school will be built on existing and growing connections between the emerging field of technology devoted to the development of intelligent avatars and interactive dialogue systems and the fundamentals of verbal and non verbal communication which includes facial expressions, tone of voice, gestures, eye contact, spatial arrangements, patterns of touch, expressive movement, cultural differences, and other "nonverbal" components. Several further key aspects will be considered, such as the integration of algorithms and procedures for the recognition of emotional states, gesture, speech and facial expressions, in anticipation of the implementation of useful applications that could be exploited to improve user access to future telecommunication services.

11. SCHOOL OUTPUT

The school output will be a book, published by a <u>designated publisher</u>. <u>Springer Verlag is among the editing press candidates</u>. It will take from 3 to 5 months after the school, in order to collect, revise and obtain a complete camera-ready manuscript for publication. Based on this schedule, the volume will be available 6 months after the actual meeting.

The book will contain contributions from the invited lecturers, as well as selected contributions from the participants. The length of the manuscript should not exceed 12-13 pages for lecturers' contributions and 5 pages for selected contributions.

Proposed contributions will undergo a peer review before being accepted for publication. The review process will start soon after the school, and participants will be notified of the revision results no later than two months after the school.

Participants should express their desire to propose a contribution and send together with the application form the title and the abstract.

12. SCHOOL COSTS

There is no registration fee for joining the school. However, a banquet is foreseen and participants who want to join the banquet (and who are not COST 2102 MC members or invited speakers) are required to pay the banquet cost which is around 35 Euros.

Coffee breaks and proceedings are covered by COST 2102.

Participants (which are not COST 2102 MC members or invited speaker) should take care of their own accommodation.
