Goals of the action	<p>Organizing Doctoral consortium <b>in</b> conjunction with 5<sup>th</sup> euCognition six-monthly meeting.</p> <p>The CogSys Doctoral Consortium will provide an opportunity for a group of senior Ph.D students who are studying aspects of Cognition systems, cognitive vision, etc., to discuss and explore their research and career objectives with a panel of established researchers in the field. Additionally, it will provide the opportunity to meet and network with other doctoral students and researchers and to initiate new research projects or develop their network of research colleagues.</p> <p>The Consortium is limited to 10 students who will be mentored by leading academics in cognition systems, cognitive vision, cognitive robotics,.. etc.</p> <p>In order to attend the Consortium, students must prepare a research proposal of their work; this should not exceed 3000 words.</p> <p>The selection criteria for the consortium are quality of the proposal and relevance to the topic of the euCognition meeting: anticipation in cognition. The Doctoral Consortium chair will assign each submission to two full members of euCognition who will provide the relevant feedback, and will be retained if judged of an acceptable quality.</p> <p><b>Doctoral consortium Format:</b> Student presentation in front of a panel of established researchers.</p> <p>The Doctoral Consortium will be held as a workshop on 28<sup>th</sup> June 2008, the day after the euCognition meeting. Students will present their work and get feedback from a panel of experienced researchers.</p> <p>Also, students will participate in a poster session held during the euCognition meeting.</p> <p><b>Organization</b> The organizers of the Doctoral consortium is Dr Samia Nefti.</p>
